Dear Parent/Carer

Each year NSW Health works with schools to offer the vaccines recommended for adolescents by the National Health and Medical Research Council (NHMRC). This is a notice to inform you of the **The NSW Health Service** vaccination schedule for 2022, with first round of vaccinations for *Year 8* taking place on *16 February 2022*.

In 2022 the following vaccines will be offered:

Year 7 students:

- Human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine in a 2-dose schedule at 0 and 6 months.
- Diphtheria, Tetanus & Pertussis (whooping cough) vaccine (dTpa) as a single dose.

Year 8 students:

- Human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine 2nd dose (missed in 2021 due to COVID restrictions)

Year 10 students:

- Meningococcal ACWY vaccine as a single dose.

Visit 2: Monday, 4 April 2022

Year 7 - dTpa and 1st dose HPV- all students

Visit 3: Thursday, 28 July 2022

If you **do not wish to have your child vaccinated** at school, or would like to withdraw consent previously given in 2021, please provide written documentation to the Head Teacher Administration Office **well before the vaccination date**. Please do not do this on the day of the clinic.

A record of vaccination will be given to all students who receive the vaccine which parents should retain and should also be provided to their GP. Please ensure that your child eats breakfast on the day of the school vaccination clinic.
